Objectives and Investment Policy

The investment objective of the Fund is to provide long term capital and income growth from a global portfolio of equities, bonds and collective investment schemes. There may be occasions when the investment manager chooses to hold a high level of cash or money market instruments.

The base currency of the Fund is pounds sterling.

Income arising from the Fund is distributed to the holders of income shares. Investors can buy and sell shares on demand when the scheme prices weekly each Thursday and the first business day of the month at 11.00am.



The risk rating of the Fund is category 5 due to the volatility of the Fund price which sits in a range of between 10% and 15%. The risk rating is calculated using historical data and a prescribed standard deviation methodology.


